Please see the village notice board for the timetable for the new Centrebus route 61 service which started on September 9<sup>th</sup>.

This now means we have a bus to and from Northampton, via Kingsthorpe on Wednesday and Saturdays.

Anyone who signs up before the activation level of 30% of the properties is reached (or has already signed up) will get a free upgrade to the next speed for the first year. So if you sign up for 50Mbps, you will get 100Mbps for the same price in the first year, etc.
