CRABTREE PIT POCKET PARK

Thank you to everyone who helped cut and rake the meadow in Sept. Over 170 volunteer hours were spent to complete this nature conservation activity. This year we have cut two thirds of the meadow, leaving the rest to provide seeds for birds and stems for wintering insects. The huge compost pile will decompose to provide an excellent habitat next year.

During the bat walk, we heard and saw Notucles and Pipestrelle bats. Other species were heard too but that requires an expert ear to identify these.

Work will continue on restoring the old lane hedgerows on Sunday 11th October at 10.30am. Please contact me if you're interested in helping then or at other times. Following this preparatory work, we'll plant the hedge saplings in November. We have been successful again in our application to the Woodland Trust for free community trees.
