Remembrance Sunday

There will be an Act of Remembrance Service in Ravensthorpe on Sunday November 8th at 10.50. It will be an abridged service, outdoors only and there will be no seating. There will also be a recorded, on-line service for Remembrance for each village, to include a village Roll of Honour and a wreath being laid at the memorial. I actively encourage all those who can watch online to do so and avoid congregating at the memorials. Masks are to be worn; we will be strictly enforcing distancing, and acting appropriately with regard to our risk assessments.

With this in mind, Christmas is coming, and will also be different. Christmas is most definitely not cancelled! Congregational singing is still not permitted. It is not possible for us to host large numbers in our buildings and maintain the required social distancing. Carol and Crib Services, for example, as we have had them in previous years cannot take place. We are looking creatively at ways that our churches can engage with our village communities and planning to celebrate the same wonderful festival, the birth of our Lord and Saviour, just in a slightly different way. Life is different, but the gospel we proclaim remains the same. Let us rejoice in this and look forward to the coming season with hope.
