## CONGRATULATIONS TO THE RAVENSTHORPE WOMEN'S INSTITUTE ON ITS 90<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY



t the beginning of August, as part of the celebrations of its 90<sup>th</sup> Birthday, the members of Ravensthorpe W.I, re-enacted the first outing made in the same month in 1919 to Teeton Hall. The original outing was made by cart, but this time they travelled in style in a beautiful 1952 Bedford coach named Camilla. The guest of honour was **Mrs. Vera Hickman**, who joined the Ravensthorpe W.I. in 1941. A Birthday Poem had been specially commissioned and **Meg Benn's** recitation turned this into a fitting toast. The weather unfortunately did not match that of 90 years ago, so rather than "playing croquet on the lawn, venturing on the pond or sitting about in the garden", after a talk on "Collecting and Drying Medicinal Herbs" (as noted in the Minutes from August 1919), members in 2009 enjoyed a delicious homemade tea and a sing song in the house while the rain poured down. Each member signed a book and over the next months will add their memories and some funny stories about their time in the W.I. Hopefully some of these will be published in future Newsletters. It was a great afternoon and lovely to have an excuse to dress up and wear hats. Thanks were expressed to **Mrs. Tice** for her kind hospitality on this special occasion.

Not only do the members have enormous fun together and take part in courses in various crafts, sports and skills; walks; outings and holidays; concerts and theatre visits, but they are at the forefront of most of the village fund raising activities.
