Unfortunately, we have had to delay the first (June) draw to the end of the month due to unforeseen circumstances, plus some teething problems with the new ticket purchasing. Judith will explain the various techniques used and the strong images produced in WW1 and WW2 art. Join us for this exciting course to find out more.


