DA/2012/0255 as above - additional plans/information. To be looked at separately. Observations: Having considered all the supplementary planning information passed to the Parish Council in two stages, the objections made are as follows: The council strongly opposes the above application.

- The siting of the proposed wind turbine is close to the A428 and would be in direct sight of drivers approaching a dangerous bend in the road. The turbine could be a distinct distraction. This is a hazardous stretch of the road where there have been a number of accidents including a recent fatality. This matter of road safety is of grave concern.
- Close to the edge of this Special Landscape Area this site would make the proposed wind turbine highly visible from a considerable area of the surrounding countryside.

**DA/2012/0892** Construction of new barn to replace existing pole barn. Construction of manage. Construction of toilet/shower block. Resiting and extension of stable an construction of tack room. Change of use of agricultural land for use of caravans, camping and static homes.

Observations: The council strongly object to this application, and would like to highlight the following Planning Policies all of which show that this application should be refused.

Policies HS6/HS10/HS21/HS24/HS33/TM5/TM2/RC6/EN1/EN25/EN39 The council has grave concerns regarding the extra traffic that would be created with caravans and horse vehicles. The site is close to a very hazardous bend and the time taken for such vehicles to pull out of the site could be crucial.

It has been brought to the attention of the parish council that this site is being used as residential without planning permission.
