Rose 'Vera' Hickman



Many of you may know that Vera Hickman passed away peacefully at Danetre Hospital on 5th April aged 95. Over £600 was donated and has been split between the Village Hall, the Playing Field and the Church

Vera's sons, Keith & Ken Hickman have kindly written about her life, serialised below:

Vera Hickam's Story (part 1)

Mother was born in Oxford in 1916 to Arthur & Emma Lapper, the third daughter of a large family. Her father worked as a drayman for the local brewery. They moved to The Plough Inn at Marsh Gibbon in about 1920. Mother liked The Plough, since it boasted a large paddock, an orchard and a large garden, but best of all, a pony and trap. She never really understood why they left to come to The Chequers in Ravensthorpe.

By now it was 1931 and Vera had left school wanting to be a hairdresser although her parents were not so keen, so she went into service as a housemaid: Vera would emphasis the 'house' part as this was one step higher than a kitchen scullery maid.

She worked at Kingsthorpe Hall, Althorpe Park and lastly at Thornby Hall owned by the Wills family of tobacco fame. Whilst at Thornby, the household would travel to Scotland for summer holidays by sleeper train and stay in a remote house south of Oban. Mother enjoyed Scotland.

Vera was married to Eric on the 10th April 1939 at St Deny's by the Rev. Long and moved into rooms in the large white house at the top of Coton Road with a Mrs Blinco.

The moved to 43, High St the following year and then onto number 45 in 1953.
