#### Easter Message from the Rev'd Andrew



A few years ago I had to deal with a 'hearing' problem. As the Chaplain amongst Deaf People my colleagues found it quite amusing that I was dealing with the frustration of not being able to hear properly.

Quite ironic don't you think? I know I am a believer of 'hands-on' experience, but really! Whilst sitting at my desk one day I was trying to listen to some music which proved rather difficult as you can imagine. As music plays such an important part of my life it was rather annoying not being able to hear properly. Thankfully, it was only a temporary problem rather than long term.

But isn't it strange how we only seem to appreciate what we've got when its gone?. For the first time in my life I'd had a taste of what it's like to be partially hearing. I was unable to hear the television properly, I was unable to hear people's voices clearly or the traffic; the lovely sound of bird-song, and worst of all, I was struggling to hear the music and songs that I love.

There have been times I must admit, when I have developed what's known as 'selective-hearing'. In particular when my wife has asked me to do something and I've chosen not to hear her request for example. Or when God has asked me to do something and I've chosen not to hear him, especially if it was to do something I'd rather not do. However, I'm pretty sure I am not alone when it comes to 'selective-hearing'.

I of course didn't need to lose part of my hearing to know how precious it is to me. But like many things in life, I took it for granted.

The above is a good reminder, to me at least, that there are times when I've took it for granted that God is there and do very little to sustain my relationship with him, for all manner of reasons. But thankfully the season of Lent always helps me to re-focus my heart and mind in order to re-build my relationship with him, through his Son Jesus Christ - as well as through prayer, study and meditation. I don't need to lose God to know that my life would be empty and meaningless without him. But it is good to be reminded of what's at stake every now and again! **Andrew**
