

First Rose

Thank you to all the volunteers who help look after the pocket park. It's looking good and is well worth a visit. We are looking forward to Spring.

The next work party is Saturday 12 March 2022 2.30pm to 4.30pm. This social, conservation task is important for wildlife. We're splitting and replanting snowdrops, amongst other tasks.

Signs of Spring are here. Primroses are flowering the woodland. The coppiced areas are helping them to spread. Primroses' name derives from Latin meaning 'first rose', even though it's not in the rose family, but it certainly is an early herald of Spring, flowering in mid February onwards. April 19th is 'Primrose day'. This date is the anniversary of the death of the former British Prime Minister Benjamin Disraeli and the primrose was his favourite flower. Queen Victoria supposed ly sent him bunches regularly and to this day primroses are laid at his statue by Westminster Abbey on this date every year.
